There is a desire of many to want us to start the Sunday services as they are showing interest in our teachings. Ongoing Goals

THEOLOGY: Since our main purpose in the country of Burundi is to do church planting, we need to have indigenous leaders who will carry this responsibility of preaching and raising up new churches. So we continue with Bible correspondence and Bible study. We also intend to introduce special training for leaders that will be conducted through modules. Therefore, the first major task is to start translating textbooks into the Kirundi language. We will also continue to manage the work in Mwanza, Tanzania to ensure that pastors there graduate from the program.

EVANCELISM: In reaching the lost, we continue to help orphans so that we can reach the community. Omelina will continue with the sewing class for women as well as teaching handcrafts. In cooperation with Tom Sanchez, we will continue to develop the radio program to reach many people in a short time.

KIRUNDI LANGUAGE: In order for us to be able to do quality work, we need to know the language of Kirundi. So, we will continue to go to class in order to be more proficient in the language.

Family Update

Our family in Tanzania is doing well. My wife and I are getting better. Omelina's arm pain is reducing and she is on pain medication. Our son Emmanuel and our granddaughter Celina are both doing well in school in Tanzania. Due to COVID along with the war in Ukraine, the economic situation has changed a lot. The cost of living has risen, a situation that leads to difficulties in running the ministry as well. But we thank God for how He gives us strength and fulfills our daily needs. We are happy to continue serving him even in all those challenges. We appreciate your prayers.


Thank Yon
