I thank God for the way He is working here in Nicaragua. He has been faithful to us and has shown us His faithfulness every day. I want to tell you what has been happening in the last few months regarding the ministries that God has placed in my hands.

Discipleship:

I thank God that He is giving me the opportunity to invest in the lives of young people. I have a group of youth, six in total, and an adult. I have been meeting with them for many months in order to introduce them to Jesus and teach them about Him. During this time, I have had the opportunity to get to know a little about each of them, their families, and the needs they have. It is a privilege to be able to walk with them in their growth process.

During this time, I have also been able to see improvements in their character and responsibility. In the case of Pedro and Ever, they have been very punctual to each meeting and they also attend the youth group. I thank God that Maykel, who was one of the young people I was investing in, found work!

I pray that they may be mature in faith and take this process very seriously.

Bible Institute:

At the beginning of September, the Bible course on the Pentateuch concluded and had an enrollment of six students. All of them finished successfully. We trust that with what they learned, the Bible institute can help improve their relationship with God.

A young couple (Sharon and Hamilton) were part of the class. They are currently leading a group of teenagers in the church and I continue to pray for the plans they have to serve in full-time ministry.



Self-Sustaining Garden Project:

The orchard at the moment is in the production process. We are harvesting hot peppers and papayas. I have had some difficult moments in terms of pests, but thanks to the help of Don Oscar, who is in charge of the maintenance of the garden, we have been able to control the situation. The garden is going well and will help fund the ministries of Arraigados Church in Nagarote.

Ministry to the Elderly:

At this time, the ministry to senior citizens is not meeting at the church because of the coronavirus, but we are always taking care of them through visits to their homes and discipleship. Two of those elderly individuals in our ministry are now with our Lord Jesus Christ.

My Marriage!

I thank God for Adela's life and mine. Though Adela and I have known each other for some time, she recently moved from Honduras to live with my mother three months ago with the goal of us being able to spend more time together in order to strengthen our relationship and to prepare us for our marriage.

Adela met the Lord Jesus at the age of 15. From there, God began to use her in the youth ministry of her church where she held positions of youth coordinator and treasurer both at the local church level and at the regional level in Honduras. She also had the opportunity to be part of Sonlife-Honduras and was able to train in Costa Rica for three months. She is eager to work alongside me while doing the Lord's work in training disciples together and to get involved in supporting the different ministries of GMI. I am very grateful to God for giving me the opportunity to meet a woman who loves God so much and because we will be able to serve God together.
