WE HAVE BEGUN OUR YEAR OF US ASSIGNMENT. The whole family traveled back from Malawi just in time for Christmas and a huge cold snap. It was quite an adjustment from 80 degrees on Monday to -37 wind chills on Friday! It was a rude welcome back!

We had a busy few months before leaving for the US as we prepared for the trip and completed ministry goals. Titus finished teaching his computer keyboarding class which is one of the ways he trains students for life and ministry at the Malawi Grace Bible School. We are looking forward to having more people skilled in typing as we continue working to translate and produce materials in the Chichewa language.

KRISTY AND MAGGIE have been meeting with ladies at our GRACE CHURCH IN AREA 23 IN LILONGWE. Kristy has been teaching them how to crochet and they sit together and talk as they work on their projects. Two of Pastor James Bandah's daughters, Blessings and Erin, have started small businesses selling some of the things they have crocheted to help with expenses and school fees.

Kristy also has made great progress in getting books ready for the MALAWI GRACE BIBLE SCHOOL LIBRARY. Our goal is to have a functioning library where Bible school students and pastors in Lilongwe can access reference books and materials. She hired Blessings and Erin as well as a couple of African Bible college students to help finish labeling and covering the books that we had on hand. They were able to finish all the books and they are now being stored in trunks on the Bible school campus. We still need funds to purchase or build shelving so that we can display the books properly. Titus has been continuing to work through the book of 1 THESSALONIANS WITH THE LILONGWE-AREA PASTORS and leaders. Unfortunately, he was unable to finish the book before it was time to fly to the US. However, Pastor James stepped up to continue organizing the Monday meeting in Titus' absence. This is what we hope for as we serve; that local leaders will take up the responsibility for the ministries in their country.

Our MALAWI GRACE BIBLE SCHOOL TRANSLATION PROJECT is continuing. Our goal is to have a complete, three-level Bible school program, in both English and
