As you may recall, in our last prayer letter we shared with you that we were preparing to leave Malawi and transition to a new season of ministry in Bolivia. We are happy to report that we arrived safely in Santa Cruz de la Sierra, Bolivia in mid-November and we have been enjoying getting better acquainted with our new team members, Talo and Patty Vergara, and their boys Lucas and Mati over the past several weeks. We previously met the Vergara family when they were serving with Grace Ministries International (GMI) in Paraguay. Being acquainted with them in Paraguay has helped with our transition to Bolivia and it is an added benefit that their boys are close in age to Nina and the children enjoy playing and spending time together.

Before arriving in Bolivia, we had the opportunity to visit Gloria's family in Brazil and Brian's family in Argentina. During this time, we completed some necessary paperwork and caught up on Amelie's vaccinations. Our time in both countries was a blessing as our families finally got to meet Amelie in person and spend quality time with Nina and us. It was refreshing to have some time to relax with family after the long flights from Malawi and the significant transition of leaving our life in Africa.

We have been in Bolivia for a little over a month and are continuing to settle in and familiarize ourselves with our new location. We are temporarily staying in an apartment adjacent to Talo and Patty Vergara's home while we wait for some repairs and renovations to be completed on the house where we will live. During our first month here we've had the opportunity to connect with several GMI-affiliated churches in the city of Santa Cruz. Brian also visited Centro Biblico de la Gracia (Grace Bible Center) where classes were winding down for the year. Much of Brian's ministry will take place here as he assists Talo Vergara with teaching the Bible school students. He has also had the opportunity to help with some youth group Bible studies over the past couple of weeks.

Please join us in praying that we will have an effective year of ministry as we settle into our new roles and responsibilities here in Santa Cruz and acclimate to a new field of ministry.

As this year comes to a close, we are deeply grateful to the Lord for each of you who have supported us—both during our time in Malawi and now as we begin this new chapter in Bolivia. As we serve the Lord in Bolivia, our goal is to build up local leaders who will continue faithfully preaching the Gospel of Grace.
