In March we began a new Bible school class in Lilongwe with 14 students. Our level 2 and 3 students in Lilongwe have also been making steady progress towards the completion of their training. This April, we had a nine-day trip to Luchenza for a Chichewa Bible School module. Even with the limitation of our ministries due to Covid-19, Joseph is still busy working on future Bible School courses and coordinating things for the days and months ahead. God is so good!

MUCH GROWTH FOR BUSINESS AND NUTRITION TRAINING

The business and nutrition training that Emmanuela runs is knowing so much success -Praise the Lord! In November last year, we graduated thirty-nine students whom Emmanuela continues to mentor as they engage in real life implementation of the skills that they learned. Emmanuela started a new class in March and so far has about a hundred and five students registered. This is a great avenue that she is already using to disciple these women as God's Word is shared before each training session. This April, Emmanuela accompanied Joseph to Luchenza as she mentored three of her Lilongwe students who taught about twenty-five women recipes, home management and even prevention measures for Covid-19. This maiden trip launched her push to take the training outside of Lilongwe. It was so well received! Praise the Lord!

TRANSFORMATIONAL CHRISTMAS PROJECTS

Thank you so much for your support for GMI's 2019 Christmas Projects. Through this support, ninety-five packages of relief food have been distributed in the war-afflicted city of Kumba in Cameroon.
