GREETINGS FROM CAMEROON!

It has been a great blessing to spend time in our home country with Emmanuela's mother, other family members, and some friends here in Cameroon. We are refreshed and ready once again to return to Malawi to continue the work of assisting the Grace Church in Malawi to train godly and capable workers to lead churches, transform communities, and build the Body of Christ in Malawi and beyond.

PRAISE POINTS: A VERY FRUITFUL SEASON OF MINISTRY:

The LORD has so far blessed this year with so many enduring fruits. Please join us to praise Him for the following. First, we thank God for the beautiful stories emerging from our efforts to economically empower the leaders we are training who are faithfully serving the LORD. With the challenging economic realities in Malawi, this work is critical. We trained seventeen leaders in 2024 and empowered them with small microloans. This year, Joseph has been visiting these leaders to see how they are doing. While a few of them had challenges with their agricultural investments due to poor weather conditions, most of them are doing well, and some of them have begun repaying the loans.

Second, Emmanuela and her Grace School of Home Economics (GSHE) team hosted forty women for two days of training in a village six hours south of Lilongwe. The team taught the women many things, including several cooking recipes and business tips, among others. Emmanuela and her team plan to visit these women again before the end of the year to finalize their training, which started in 2021. This year has also been a great year for the regular GSHE training in Lilongwe. Emmanuela and her team are super pleased with the commitment of the current batch of students. Thirty-four of them started this journey in October 2024, and 28 will be graduating in September!

Third, we praise the LORD that in May, Joseph and Dr. Bill Vinton taught a two-day teacher orientation seminar for eleven Malawian teachers at Malawi Grace Bible School. This was a huge milestone as seven of the eleven are new teachers at MGBS. Our training ministry

is expanding rapidly, and we can only keep up with the demand by adding more instructors from the Grace Church in Malawi. Our endgame is always to train enough Malawians to take over the ministries that we do. God has blessed us greatly in the ministry of leadership training and theological education as we are edging towards this endgame. The seven new teachers have since been attending Bible School modules to receive practical orientation.

Fourth, we are thanking God that in the middle of May, Joseph travelled to Kabwe, Zambia, for ten days to help the Grace Church in Zambia continue in the process of resuscitating their Leadership Training and Theological Education program. We praise God for the twenty-two students who completed the module in Kabwe.

Fifth, Joseph and Pastor James Bandah (a Grace Church leader) spearheaded the organization of our annual leadership training conference that continues to provide training and care to pastors and leaders. It was such a blessed time when fifty-four Grace Church leaders from across Malawi gathered in southern Malawi for a week of training and fellowship. New leadership for the Grace Church in Malawi was also elected during the conference. The LORD added a special blessing by bringing GMI Executive Director Jeremy Clark, along with the Lead Pastor of Rush Creek Bible Church, Cameron Townley, and the Administrator of Rush Creek, Brett Elder to visit. Although they stayed for just a few hours, the LORD used them all to bless the leaders so much.


