A good example is the Arauz family who travels almost two hours every Sunday to attend Comunidad Bíblica de La Gracia (Grace Bible Community). In addition to attending regularly, several family members also serve on the Worship Team. They say Comunidad Bíblica de La Gracia does not look like any other church they had previously attended. They report that they experience grace, love, and brotherhood here; things they didn't know, understand, or experience before coming to our church. We want the grace and love of Jesus Christ to be our identity as a church family and thus

fulfill the law of Christ as Galatians 5:14 states.





Worship Team

The focus of each of our ministries is to show the grace of Jesus by going deeper with our biblical teaching. The Wednesday Bible studies and men's and women's groups on the weekends are valuable opportunities to build relationships as well as terrific channels for teaching biblical truth and sound doctrine to our church members.

Alvaro is leading the men's group at the church where we seek to remind and teach the men about Biblical masculinity, living their lives in Christ, and the role they have in leading their families, children, and the church based on the Biblical model found in Ephesians chapter five.



At the same time, Mauren is investing her time in the women to develop and strengthen their understanding of their identity in Christ and God's plan for their lives. Some of the women who participate in this group have not attended the church yet, but are greatly benefiting from this study as they are in great need of finding their identity and value in Christ Jesus. One of them is Katherine Quiroz who has been our friend for more than four years. Over the past four years, we have been investing our time and resources in her and her family to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with them. The process has been slow and it has not been easy, but despite all of the barriers and difficulties, we have seen God at work and they are beginning to see the wonders of God's promises for the Body of Christ.



For Good Friday we planned a picnic and a camp day with church members and some other guests. We traveled to a beautiful place two hours away from the city of David where there are rivers and hot springs. During our time there, we had a time of praise and a short teaching from the Bible on what Passover means to us the Body of Christ. We are so grateful that Eduardo and Verónica Córdoba (a young adult couple from the church) took the leadership in organizing this event. It was a wonderful chance to have fun, build trust, and celebrate communion with our brothers and sisters from the church. As Psalms 133:1 says, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity."



Please join us in praying that the church here in Panama continues to walk and grow in the Lord's will. Pray also that our Grace Ministries International Panama team will work together, using the gifts God has given each of us, to accomplish His purposes as we serve the local church.
