Since the last time we shared our news with you, wonderful things have been happening in Panama. As last year was coming to an end, we could feel the Christmas spirit in the air. Even though we had many restrictions due to the pandemic, people had the desire to celebrate at least a little bit of the Christmas season. That feeling encouraged us and challenged us to creatively gather the families in our neighborhood outdoors to do something special to share Jesus with them.

We were able to have a wonderful event with about 25 people who loved the play that our Panama team alongside our Kids Bible Club Children had prepared narrating the birth of our Savior Jesus Christ.

As part of our outreach strategies initiating the year and taking advantage of our summer time, we've held several outreach activities in a nearby neighborhood with the objective to meet and connect with more people as we share the gospel and invite them to visit our church. Normally, we have an attendance of about 10 kids during our outreach events. Many of them come with their parents who are very appreciative that we provide these opportunities for their kids to socialize after a long lockdown period. Most importantly, they are very grateful to expose them to the message of the saving grace of our Lord Jesus.
