"Context is king."

We repeat the chant loudly, a classroom of eager young students in our very first Bible Institute class. "Context is king." It echoes in my thoughts as I remind my class, but this time as the teacher, and in Spanish (thankfully, it's one of those easy ones where you can just add the "O").

"Contexto! Contexto!" they say it with me. This has been the motto for our introductory Bible Institute class, "How to study the Bible."

As we look into God's Word and at different methodologies for Bible study, we are putting verses in their broader context and gaining more understanding of the author's original intent. One of the students, an associate pastor, told me that now he has to change how he preaches. He realized that a sermon he preached recently was out of context and his application was not at all what the verse is saying. Learning is fueling his passion to study the Bible so he can continue to share it with others. He is excited to take more classes and become better equipped to teach and impact his community.

Our goal in Nicaragua is to evangelize, disciple, and train leaders to plant churches with members and attenders who know, understand, and live out the grace of God.

Second Timothy 2:2 says, "You then, my child be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."

Like a relay runner with a baton, we are handing off what we have learned to faithful people who will continue to pass it on to others. There are many churches here, and much religion, but there is a great need for solid grace-based, biblical teaching that will help equip people for life and ministry. As they receive theological education and cultivate their love for God's Word, it will grow and spread exponentially as they pass on what they learn with others.

Classes in the "Instituto Biblico Arraigados" will be open to the community in February with another round of "How to Study the Bible" as well as "Christian Life." The Spanish word "Arraigados" means rooted and we have taken this term from Colossians 2:6-7: "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted [Arraigados] and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving."

Thank you for being connected with the work God is doing with Grace Ministries International in Nicaragua. Through your support and prayer, lives are being impacted with the gospel of Grace and the power of God's Word. Your partnership helps us to reach out in our city and share His love with families in our neighborhood, to offer discipleship and training, and most recently, to begin Bible Institute classes.
