Dear beloved brothers and sisters,

As I write this letter, my heart overflows with gratitude. Thank you for your prayers, encouraging messages, financial support, and for continuing to walk alongside me in ministry here in Paraguay. Many of the blessings I share today are a direct result of God's faithfulness working through your prayers and support. Before sharing any updates, I simply want to say "thank you"!

Many of you have been praying for my health since I contracted Chikungunya, and I am grateful to report that I have improved significantly. Despite some complications during my recovery, God has been faithful. Through medical care, healthier habits, and regular exercise, I have regained my strength, lost weight, and now feel much better. Thank you for your prayers throughout this journey.

I am also grateful to share that I have begun the process of obtaining permanent residency in Paraguay. Changes in the law made the process more complicated and costly than expected, requiring additional documents and procedures. However, God faithfully provided everything that was needed, and I am now waiting for the final documentation to be issued. This will allow me to continue serving in Paraguay with greater stability and without the constant need to renew temporary visas.

In the La Blanca neighborhood, ministry continues to move forward. Our Mitãnguéra children's ministry continues to reach children each week, while our guitar classes remain a valuable tool for evangelism and discipleship. These ministries provide opportunities not only to teach practical skills but also to share the love of Christ with children and their families. We are also developing strategies to plant a new church in this neighborhood. With the arrival of new missionaries, Juan and Lucre Chaves, we have been able to dream, plan, and prepare for new opportunities to reach even more people with the Gospel.

At Iglesia Bíblica Bereana, one of my greatest joys has been watching God raise up new leaders. In our women's ministry, one woman has officially begun a season of discipleship and leadership training. She has already started participating in teaching our women's Bible studies, and my goal is to prepare her to eventually lead this ministry.

I am also encouraged by the growth of our media ministry. Today, Fher, Paula, and Débora lead a team of approximately ten volunteers who serve with a high level of autonomy. Watching these young people take ownership of ministry and faithfully serve the Lord has been a tremendous blessing.

Another great blessing over the past few months has been the growth of the Alcance Hypyty Project within the indigenous community. Thanks to your prayers and support, we held a large evangelistic outreach that reached

approximately 460 people. It was a special day filled with opportunities to share the Gospel and demonstrate the love of Christ in practical ways.

What has touched my heart most, however, is seeing God work through the community chief. After placing his faith in Christ, he has become a strong supporter of the ministry and often reminds us that his people need God. For many years, indigenous communities have resisted the establishment of churches within their territories, but today God has opened a door that once seemed impossible. The chief not only welcomes our presence but also supports the vision of planting the first church within his community.

At this stage, I am strengthening relationships and investing in the training of future indigenous leaders so that one day this church can be led by members of the community. At the same time, we continue to face transportation challenges. Road conditions make access difficult, especially during the rainy season. For this reason, I continue to pray that God will provide the resources needed to purchase a pickup truck, which would greatly help us transport equipment and supplies and enable us to serve more effectively in this remote area.

I would also appreciate your prayers regarding my U.S. visa process. Due to scheduling complications, my interview was postponed, and I am still waiting for a new appointment date. I trust God's timing completely and ask that His will be accomplished throughout this process.

Looking ahead, we are excited about several upcoming opportunities. We have begun preparations for the second Bible Conference at Iglesia Bíblica Bereana, and we are also praying about a possible ministry trip to Brazil with several members of our church. We have been invited to visit a church in Ponta Grossa that GMI planted many years ago, and we are grateful for the opportunity to strengthen these relationships and encourage fellow believers. As I reflect on all that God has done, my heart is filled with gratitude. Every child reached, every leader trained, every Bible study taught, and every door opened for the Gospel exists because you have chosen to partner with us in this ministry.

Thank you for every prayer, every word of encouragement, and every financial gift! You are an essential part of what God is doing here in Paraguay.

- The training of the future women's ministry leader.
- Wisdom as we prepare for the first church plant within the indigenous community.

- My US visa process.
- The completion of my Paraguayan permanent residency documentation.
- The upcoming Bible Conference and ministry trip to Brazil.
