We hope this letter finds you trusting the Lord and in good health. Most of you know that we are still in the USA visiting churches. We are staying in Wayne, NJ in the parsonage of Preakness Bible Church. In general we are doing very well but it has been a little challenging sometimes. We know the Lord is in control and also we trust that everything will work for our good and for His Glory! (Romans 8:28)

Since we are not American citizens, we had to ask for an extension of our time in the USA and are still waiting for an answer. Even when we are looking forward to going back to Paraguay, we hope that the answer from the immigration authorities will be positive so we can remain in the USA until we can return to our mission field.

# A lot of Bible Studies online!

We spent around four months in Grand Rapids, MI in total quarantine! We used the time to serve the church in Paraguay

and other churches with Bible studies and preaching online.

Alex continues to be in charge of the weekly Bible Study of our church in Paraguay. We have people attending the Bible Study from Argentina, Uruguay, Brazil and Colombia. We are studying "The Gospel and Evangelism," hoping that God will use His Word to motivate the church to share the hope that we have in Christ.

Another study online is with four young men from the German Mennonites Colonies of Paraguay. It has been a privilege to meet weekly with them and go deeper into God's Word. We always talk about different topics of the Christian life: marriage, family, parenting, courtship, missions, and biblical manhood.

A pastor from a church in Uruguay asked Alex to teach a course on "Cult and Religions." Around 20 students participated. We studied Catholicism, Jehovah's Wit-

nesses, Mormons, Seventh Day Adventists, Muslims, Buddhists, Freemasons, and various others groups. The response from the students was very positive, so we will have another course about Apologetics in the coming weeks.

During the quarantine time in Michigan, Alex was preaching every other Sunday for our church in Paraguay. Since we left Michigan we have continued preaching online whenever possible.

Alex is teaching a Bible lesson every Friday morning for a high school in Ciudad del Este, and he is participating once a week in a YouTube Live with pastors from Chile, Peru, and Uruguay to discuss various topics from a biblical perspective but without the formality of a Bible study in church.

After leaving Michigan, we went to Alabama for a month. We had the opportunity to visit four churches in Mobile
