During the last four months since purchasing the property, we have made some great improvements and additions to the property. We will have a nursery, classrooms, a kitchen, and of course our worship area. We praise God that the contractor, Pedro, is both honest and competent. He has been doing a great job. We are very pleased with the progress of the building.

First, Timmy has been having a very difficult time doing his virtual classes, which has been inhibiting his Spanish acquisition. Please pray for patience for him (and us) as we navigate this frustrating time. Please pray for Paraguay as a country, too. There have been almost no vaccinations here. Hospitals throughout the country are severely overcrowded and lacking resources.
