

• Zimbabwe is where Bill Vinton, member of our GMI team in Malawi, led the third of six seminars for English-speaking African teachers and church leaders called the International Teacher Training Program. Leaders from Malawi, Zambia and Zimbabwe all attended this session from November 23 to December 3. Bill taught nearly 50 hours on the Book of Acts during this module. The Director of Training in Zambia who has been a pastor for 18 years is eager to go back and hold several four-day seminars for all the pastors and elders of the Grace Churches in Zambia in 2022.

- Traveling to Bonaire and Curacao, GMI team members Lawrence and Barbara Trumbower gave several theological and biblical presentations for the ministries and churches on both islands. At one meeting in Bonaire, a lady was greatly impacted by the Sunday morning lesson and felt a renewed freedom in her relationship with the Lord after coming to a better understanding of prayer.
- *Nicaragua*. Thirty young people attended the youth camp run by the GMI team and the leadership of Arraigados Church in the town of Nagarote. The challenge of the camp, taken from John 15, was to remain in Jesus, His love and in His Word. Two of those who have been faithful in the ministry of Arraigados over the years are Yilber and Mercedes. In December, they were the first students to graduate from Grace Bible Institute which meets on the church property.
- *In Paraguay,* the Sunday before Christmas, 130 attended the service at Grace Bible Church in Ciudad del Este. This is quite an encouragement to the GMI team which is now planning to start another church in this sprawling, met-

- ropolitan area bordering Argentina and Brazil. Efforts towards this end are already underway as the team looks forward to 2022 as the pivotal year to establish a new congregation. In addition, the team has seen growth and consistency in their Bible studies across the border in Foz de Iguazu, Brazil. The team hopes to facilitate a church plant there as well.
- Thanks to the Hansens for their last five years of ministry with GMI in Bolivia. There are now nearly 60 students taking classes at the recently constituted Grace Bible Center in Santa Cruz and a group of men who were the first to undergo the ordination process through Misión Evangélica Bethesda (the association of churches with which GMI serves in Bolivia). Praise the Lord for the two who successfully fulfilled their ordination requirements! It is a testament to the Lord's faithfulness for all that has been accomplished during these past five years through Frosty and Cathy's ministry. The Hansens saw elongated times of significant civil unrest and months of strict government restrictions these past few years. In spite of all this, the Lord has been good!
