What a strange year this has been! In the midst of COVID-19, Malawi had new elections in June as a result of the constitution court ruling. Malawi elected a new president, and the results are not being challenged this time. This has resulted in a new sense of hope among the people and the violence and protests of the past year have subsided. Malawi had stayed relatively untouched by COVID-19, until a new wave of cases started in late December. This was triggered by thousands of Malawians repatriating from South Africa due to the problems there and bringing a new strain to Malawi.

Titus continues to meet with the Lilongwe pastors on a regular basis, studying with them, and encouraging them. They are currently working through the book of 2 Timothy. He also had the opportunity to teach Computer 1 to our Level 1 English-speaking Malawi Grace Bible School students. He also continues to work to get all of our Bible school courses translated into Chichewa.
