Hello Family and Friends,

Greetings from Panama. We hope you have been doing well and you are enjoying your summer.

In our last letter, we told you we were in the process of finding a place to have our church services and other ministries. We are happy to report that at the end of March we found a building to rent for our church meetings and we began meeting in the building

in the month of April. The church building is centrally located in the city of David, close to a high foottraffic area with a bus stop nearby. This building is in a great location for the general population to see the church. Our ultimate goal and hope is to one day purchase our own property here in Panama so that we can build our own church building and other church facilities.

Our church, Comunidad Bíblica de la Gracia, has services Sunday mornings from 10am to noon. We have a time of worship followed by the sermon. During the sermon portion of the service, Comunidad Biblica de la Gracia also has Sunday school for kids. Jaque and GMI team member Mauren Barrantes, along with a young lady, Julia, who is a member of the church, serve as the Sunday school teachers.

Our church also has a Bible study class every Thursday. Currently, we are studying the book, "Understanding your Bible," by Pastor Craig MacDonald. This class has

> been awesome for helping our church members and other attendees to better understand God's Word while also teaching them to rightly divide and handle God's Word. As our team looks to the future, we hope to continue having

more Bible studies, exploring other Bible textbooks to help members and Bible students to better understand the Bible and how God has interacted with human beings throughout history. It has been super encouraging to see how those in attendance are excited about better understanding God's Word.

Ronnie started a martial arts ministry at the beginning of May with just three students. This ministry was named Academia Arraigados, which translates to "Rooted Academy." In Colossians 2:6-7, God's Word tells us that we are to

His goal was to first start with three students and train them up as his first leaders. Academia Arraigados held its first belt test in the last week of June and all three students obtained their first promotion to ninth level—white belt with a vellow stripe! These students were awarded their new rank and belt at our church as part

Panama is a relatively young field as our team continues sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with the people of David and the surrounding areas. Through this, we also hope that Panamanian nationals will join the church and become part of the Body of Christ. We hope that they too, will come to understand, know, and rightly divide God's Word, as it says in 2 Timothy 2:15.
