Single Mothers tMinistry

We graduated eight ladies from our Single Mothers program this year and sent them out to run small businesses. Some have managed to get big contracts from local lodges to supply soap. Please pray that the cohort of 20 new single mothers who have entered this program will be sufficiently trained as they are prepared to be sent out with the skills they have learned. Skills trainers (teachers) are being equipped to continue training future groups of single mothers even after we leave to begin our new ministry in Mozambique. Along with learning valuable skills, the single mothers work through essential Bible studies during their meetings. Pray as well that these ladies will cultivate a closer walk with God. We are thankful for your prayers for these single mothers. The lives of these mothers and their children are being changed through skills training, the Word of God, and your prayers and donations. Thank you.

Cancer Aid

Some of you have heard the news that our son, J-Nathan, has been diagnosed with cancer again. He was diagnosed with leukemia in 2018 and he endured over three years of treatment before the cancer went into remission. He had not been feeling well for the past several months and after undergoing medical tests he was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma last month which

Pig Forming

Thank you for partnering with us in helping to eliminate poverty in Mbewa Village. The ladies are beginning to realize some rewards for their hard work. We have eleven new piglets, and we have four sows that are expecting to give birth to more piglets within a month or two. The ladies are excited. The new motorbike, which was part of the GMI 2022 Christmas Catalog, will help the ladies with buying feed and selling their pigs as it will make transporting feed and piglets much easier on the difficult roads in the area.
