She was surprised in several ways when she and her team visited southern Malawi in November of 2024. There were more single mothers than they anticipated in the two districts that they visited. Her team had planned to provide training for 50 single mothers but ended up training over 120. The Beauty for Ashes ministry is positively impacting the lives of single mothers and the lives of their children in profound ways. We praise the Lord that 26 single mothers graduated in September 2024. Fifty women are enrolled for the new session that started in January and Sylvia and her teaching team are eager to see how the Lord will work in their lives. Pig Farming

Many of the homes are well along in their construction and the ladies can hardly wait to move into them. While raising pigs has been life-changing for these women, finding a good, stable market for selling the grown pigs can be challenging.
