On December 1 we will be celebrating our sixth wedding anniversary! The day we were married we decided Acts 20:24 would be our life verse: "However, I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace."

We arrived in Nicaragua with the goal of helping to develop qualified workers, as it says in 2 Tim 2:2, "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others."

Maybe this has been our most difficult year of ministry because of the crisis in Nicaragua, and because we had to cancel the visits of our USA teams during the summer. These teams bring a lot of momentum every year to our ministry and so much gets done in the area of construction. It has also been hard to work through a social, economical, and political crisis that is affecting every family. However, this

is the first time we are seeing fruit in the lives of people in whom we have invested for almost nine years.

Over the years we have developed relationships through personal discipleship, various ministries in a church building, and a Bible Institute. For a long time we were the only tools available for teaching in Nagarote, which was very tiring. But there is nothing more rewarding than seeing a plant with its firstfruits, and that we can have a presence in the lives of Marvin, Yilber, Mercedes, Larry, and Maynor.

Last August, Marvin and Yilber left for Costa Rica to have intensive leadership training as part of a Sonlife program. They have returned to be part of our leadership team. This allows us to dream in multiplication around Nicaragua. They have made known to us their interest in finishing their theological degrees at the Bible Institute. They want to go out to other areas of Nicaragua to have their part in the ministry and follow the steps of Jesus.

What great joy and happiness to walk in faith to fulfill an objective together.

In the same way, we want to continue investing in people like Mercedes, Larry, Laleska, Maynor, Yordin, Maikel, Mariely, Anthony, and Margine, in whom we see great potential and who learn every day how to be a true disciple of Christ, as it says in 1 John 2: 6, "Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did." They are also serving in the ministry and helping to share with the churches that have invited us all in Nicaragua to train their leaders in the life of Christ and in the study of the Bible. Pray much for each of them and for the ministry that God will develop through them in Nicaragua and the world.

This is what we mean to see God working faithfully and blessing beyond our imagination, only in a different way than we expected. They are always His plans and not ours.

But the tranquility that opens the doors to the teams during the year 2019 has arrived. This is our great prayer at this moment, which could be an injection of courage for a town that was left in a total depression.
