NEXT STEPS/NEEDS

• Need for finances. To build classrooms, offices, and an auditorium to continue investing in people's lives. We pray for more churches interested in sending teams to have a missionary experience in Nicaragua and be a part of this project.

• Need for more servants. We need more missionaries in Nicaragua who can be a part of our team and people who can come for a short time to serve in the ministry in an internship program. We also pray that God would work in the hearts of Nicaraguans to raise leaders capable of faithfully teaching the Word of Truth and that people would stop being fearful of what God has challenged them to do.

• Need for more prayer. We also ask for more people engaged in prayer. May they pray for: 1) much fruit in Nicaragua, 2) the lives of people in whom we invest and multiply through discipleship, 3) our spiritual lives, and 4) our marriage. We want to have a team of warriors in prayer supporting us every day.

That is why we share some of the next steps and needs for this project in the sidebar.

During the month of April we made a trip through Puerto Rico, New York and Michigan in the United States, and Costa Rica. The main purposes of this trip were to be part of two mission conferences and a confer-

ence of leaders, visit churches, meet people who are part of this ministry, and seek help to meet the needs in Nicaragua. For us it was a privilege to be able to learn so much during this experience.
