I continue to be involved in the development of leaders for this ministry, providing ongoing support and discipleship to ensure that the church will be self-sustaining in the future. A young man named Fher who has shown great potential, is being trained to take over the media team next year, allowing me to focus on other vital areas of ministry. In addition, a young woman named Lili has taken on the role of our children's ministry director. We are very grateful for her dedication and effort in this important ministry. It is exciting to see the growth of our community and their increasingly deep understanding of their role in the body of Christ.

Women's Bible Study

Leading the women's Bible studies has been a blessing! I have worked hard to make these gatherings warm and welcoming so the women feel secure in sharing and asking for help when needed. It is wonderful to see how we can support each other and grow together in Christ through the Word of God. In addition to leading the study, I walk with each sister in the church, offering continuous encouragement and support. It's beautiful to witness how God has been working in their lives through these gatherings. Love and care are demonstrated through this and I have already seen many positive changes in their lives.

Mbarakapu - Guitar Classes

I have started a ministry called Mbarakapu, which means "sound of the guitar" in the native language. These classes are becoming a powerful tool for evangelism, providing a safe environment for children and youth to learn not only how to play the guitar but also Christ-centered songs. We are seeing an increasing number of parents interested in guitar lessons which is extremely rewarding as it represents an opportunity to share the gospel with entire families.
